In Oman, OCI's domestic market share stands at around 77 per cent. OCI claims to have captured 70 per cent of Oman's LV power cable market and 80 per cent of the building wires

It posted a net profit of RO 1.368 million in 2004, showing a growth of 82 per cent over 2003. Significantly, OCI has achieved 52 per cent Omanisation, exceeding the prescribed target of 35 per cent.

Oman Cables' expansion project, completed in 2004, marked the manufacturing of medium voltage (MV) underground cables up to 33/36 kv grade.

During this phase, OCI acquired the most modern production and testing equipment available.

The expansion plans are paying off very well. OCI achieved a new milestone during 2004 with its turnover exceeding RO 36 million (\$92 million), showing a growth of 62 per cent over 2003.

Exports have jumped to 55 per cent of the total turnover and have made forays in prestigious markets such as GCC countries, Australia, the UK, Japan, South Korea and Africa. This is in sharp contrast to the scenario just two decades ago when Oman used to source MV cables from the UK.

Hussain feels the tide is finally turning because OCI has reversed the history with these products being exported to the UK and other European countries from Oman.
